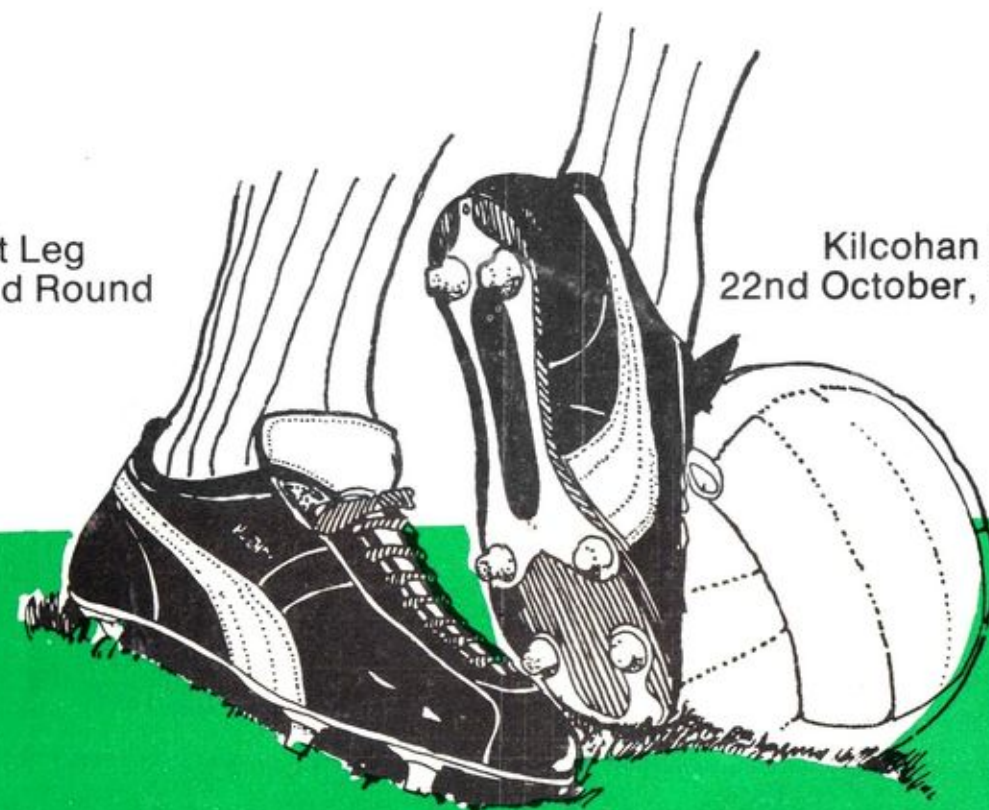

Britain will have to fall into line with the Union of European Football Associations and impose a ceiling on transfer fees, claims Mick Mills, Ipswich's captain and England full-back. Mills is concerned about the growing exodus of stars from these shores to the continent.

"It now seems a matter of time before other stars follow Liam Brady, Kevin Keegan, Laurie Cunningham and Tony Woodcock abroad. As far as I can see we will have to get in line with U.E.F.A. who have a £500,000 ceiling on fees or we will have to make foreign clubs pay the sort of money the players would be worth at home. But let's not knock the lads who have gone abroad, everyone in any walk of life wants to better themselves and a footballer is no different from the thousands of engineers, oil workers and others who have invaded the Arab states in search of rich pickings.

It is not often you find Liverpool near the bottom of the table, but a list published of admission prices for top stand seats in the First Division finds the League Champions in the relegation zone.

They charge £2.50 for all seats and only Middlesbrough are cheaper at £2.30.

Most expensive to watch are Brighton at £4.50, followed by Arsenal and Coventry. West Brom and Wolves are at £3.70. But Brighton fans do not mind since there are pretty majorettes to entertain them before matches at the Goldstone Ground.

Charlie Hurley, the former Sunderland player, and Irish international was voted "Player Of The Century" by Sunderland supporters throughout Britain.

Sammy McElroy, Manchester United's midfield star and present captain of Northern Ireland, is well on the way to his 300th League game. He will never forget his debut at Old Trafford at the age of 17. That was on November 13, 1971, when he lined-up in a front line which read: Willie Morgan (Scotland) McElroy, Bobby Charlton (England), Denis Law (Scotland), and George Best (Ireland). United beat Spurs 3-1, Sammy scoring the first goal.

English exile Tony Knapp has been helping to set Scandinavia on fire in the season that has just finished. Tony, former Southampton, Leicester, Coventry and Tranmere centre-half has just arrived back at his home in Norwich after an unprecedented hat-trick of success in the Norwegian League.

Now 42 years of age, he has won the First Division Championship, the Norwegian Cup and the Youth Cup, as coach to the Stavanger Club, Viking. Now Knapp faces his sixth year out of the last season playing in major European competition when he starts next season in the European Cup with Viking.

He has coached Iceland in the World Cup and European championship, earned a memorable draw with East Germany with his team of amateurs and in the U.E.F.A. Cup last season also earned a draw with Borussia Munchengladbach.

He has signed another two-year contract with Viking after turning down a tempting offer to go back to Iceland as national team manager.

Says Tony: "We have a great set-up in Stavanger. But we have to produce our own players. Last season we paid a record transfer fee of £3,000 for one new player."

The reserves would like to extend a céad míle fáilte to the players and officials of Dinamo Tbilisi on their first visit to this country and hope their stay in Waterford is enjoyed by all.

In the last three games we have played, we have taken three points. The first was against Dublin University which ended in a one all draw. Incidentally, it was nice to see Liam Tuohy at this game. Liam is manager of the University side and would be well-known to the older supporters of the Blues from his playing days with Shamrock Rovers. The following Sunday we played Tullamore and at the end of a good game, we won by 3 goals to 1. Last Saturday we played St. Pats in Richmond and were beaten by 2 goals to nil. This was a very good game with both goals coming in the last 10 minutes and it was a case of which team scored first would win.

In recent weeks we have been joined by some new players and I would like to say welcome to those players. They are Anthony Cooney who played youth football with Hibs. Anthony plays at full-back or midfield. Then we have Alan Barry from De La Salle who plays at centre-half. Alan is the son of Billy Barry, who had a long and distinguished career in the No. 5 shirt for Waterford as all Blues followers will know and we hope Alan will follow in his footsteps. Lastly we have John (Doler) Burns, who has been making a name for himself in the Junior League with Ferrybank. John plays in midfield or up front.

To finish the reserves we would like to wish the seniors the best of luck to-day against Dinamo and look forward to them getting a good result to take with them to Russia.

DINAMO TBILISI

Tbilisi is the capital of Georgia (the name was changed from Tiflis in 1936) and the state itself has a population of some five million people, while Tbilisi itself boasts a population of more than 900,000. Dinamo Tbilisi are the club from the city, which lies in the valley of the River Kura, in the Caucasus.

The citizens are keen on their football, and there are two grounds which are available for big matches. Dinamo can use a giant stadium which can accommodate 100,000 spectators, but they sometimes play at the Lokomotiv Stadium, which houses about 40,000 people.

Founded in 1924, the club has a distinguished record in Russian Soccer and they have gained a lot of experience on the European circuit. Their normal colours are white shirts (blue collar and blue edging at the end of the sleeve) and they display the letter "D" on their team jersey.

Although they won the Russian League in 1964, Dinamo didn't compete in the European Cup the following season, because Russia had no entry. They have been runners-up in the Premier Division four times, and they won the championship again in 1979.

Since the League came into existence in 1936, Dinamo have finished in the lower half on only two occasions and then occupied ninth place.

The club has had mixed fortunes when it came to the Cup, because they were runners-up on five occasions before winning the trophy in 1976. Forty years previously they were beaten 2-0 by Lokomotiv Moscow in the final; in 1973 they met Moscow Dynamo and went down 5-2; nine years later they lost 3-2 to Moscow Spartak; in 1960 Moscow Torpedo scored a 4-3 victory over them; and in 1970 it was Moscow Dynamo who beat them 2-1.

Their luck turned in September, 1976 when they took the Russian Cup by beating Ararat 3-0, and they won it again in 1979 and in 1980, making them Cup specialists of the Soviet Union.

This season Dinamo Tbilisi are competing in Europe for the seventh time. They have played four times in the E.U.F.A. Cup, twice in the cup-winners' Cup and once, last season, in the Champions' Cup.

They are one of 16 clubs in First Division Football in Russia, where it pays to play for a win. As in this country, a team picks up a single point when they play a draw game, but after eight draws, they get no more points and this sounds like a very interesting innovation.

The Russian football year begins towards the end of March and finishes about mid-November, so Dinamo are drawing to the end of their season.

So we are calling on everyone's co-operation to ensure he will have nothing but praise for the Waterford supporters. So please do not go inside the railings, do not sit on the railings and do not leave your children inside the railings and after the final whistle, do not come on to the pitch.

Everyone is aware by now the return game in Russia will cost in the region of £20,000 so we cannot afford to pay fines of possibly £5,000 on top of our other expenses.

Give the team plenty of vocal support.

At to-day's game we will have a presentation of two outstanding F.A.I. Cup medals which the club secured for Richie Hall and Brendan Carey, both players played a major part in bringing the Cup back to Waterford. The F.A.I. normally present just 13 medals for the players taking part in the Cup final on the day.

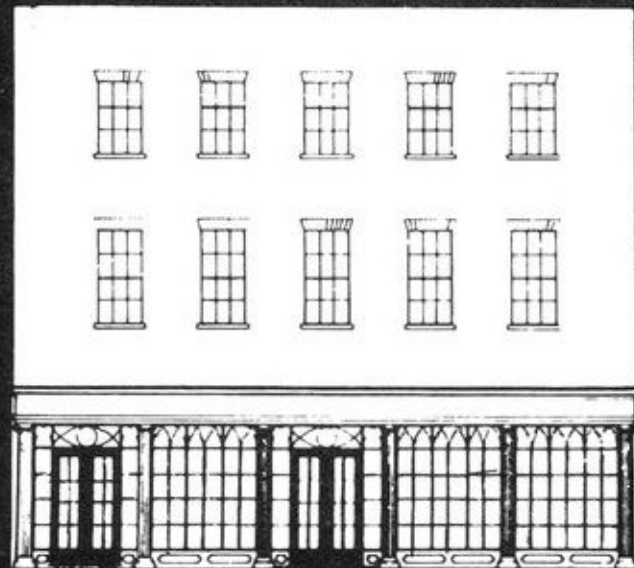
